How Inaccurate Voter Rolls Impact Election Outcomes

In Georgia's November 2020 elections, it appears that 67,284 votes were cast from ineligible voter registrations based on invalid residency.* 19,077 votes were assigned to records of voters who no longer lived in Georgia. 48,207 votes were assigned to voters who had moved to a different county within Georgia.

The state of Georgia mailed ballots to 16,986 addresses where voters no longer lived, yet the votes were still cast and counted. Additionally, 8,984 of these votes were assigned to inactive voter registration records. Who voted these ballots?

- At least 67,284 ineligible votes were counted in 2020
- 48,207 votes were cast by voters who no longer lived in the county of their registration
- 19,077 votes were cast by voters who no longer lived in the state
- Of the 19,077 votes, 16,986 were mail ballots
- Of the 16,986 mail ballots, 8,984 records were inactive according to state data.
